



Ebbe Munk
(Director-Copenhagen)

We are delighted to welcome Ebbe Munk to direct the Summer Music School for the seventh time.

He has been the conductor of the Copenhagen Royal Chapel Choir since 1991. He was himself a chorister and later read musicology at Copenhagen University. After studying choral conducting in Dresden, Munich, Budapest and the United States, he founded the Chamber Choir Vox Danica, specialising in modern choral music. The many CDs he has made with this choir, especially of Danish choral music, have received considerable acclaim both in Denmark and abroad. He has performed at numerous concerts in Europe with Sankt Annae Gymnasiekor which he conducted from 1982–1991.

It is, however, primarily as the conductor of the Copenhagen Royal Chapel Choir that Ebbe has performed in concert halls and cathedrals all over the world. With this choir he has directed a number of major choral works with leading Danish orchestras and is involved in the production of many CDs of Danish choral music from the 18th Century to the present.

Since 2002 he has been artistic counsellor of the Fédération des Choeurs de l'Union in Bruxelles. Together with the CRCC Ebbe was honoured in Paris by l'Institut de France-Académie des Beaux-Arts with the Prix chant choral Liliane Bettencourt. In April 2015 he was appointed a Knight of Dannebrog of first degree by her Majesty Queen Margrethe II.

Judy Bellingham (Vocal Teacher-Dunedin)

Judy Bellingham is Associate Professor of Voice at Otago University. She had an active career both nationally and internationally as a singer, but has now retired from the concert stage.

She continues however as a respected and inspirational teacher. As a clinician, Judy has presented workshops in Australia, England, America and Taiwan, and has taught for Glyndebourne Festival Opera. She is Artistic Director of the New Zealand Singing School, and is highly regarded as both a vocal and choral adjudicator. She has recorded a CD of New Zealand song, DVD's Songs of Old Dunedin, and Warm Me Up, Judy! She has published a book Sing what you see, See what you sing. Judy was appointed a Member of the New Zealand Order of Merit in the Queen's 90th Birthday Honours List in 2016.

Jonathan Berkahn (Accompanist-Wellington)

Jonathan holds a BMus in composition and a BMus (Hons) in performance (organ, harpsichord, fortepiano) and a PhD in music history. He has been teaching at the NZ School of Music in Wellington.



MOZART & MORE...

In 2018 Teapot will celebrate the birth of the bel canto tradition with Mozart's Mass in C. The focus on the bel canto singing is not only in the beautiful & demanding choir parts but also in the two solo soprano parts — some of the most spectacular vocal music in the field of church music.

And in Vienna, at the same time as Mozart, was another great composer, Dmitriy Bortnjanskij (1751-1828). He was composer at the court of the Emperor of Russia. He adapted the instrumental concerts into some fabulous Choral concertos with his Russian bel canto style.

2018 is also the year to celebrate the 75th anniversary of one of the greatest choir composer of our own time. Morten Lauridsen's Shining Night gives us a contemporary bel canto style.
